COMPUTER OPERATOR

Time Commitment	8:00am – 12:15. Every 3rd Sunday Occasional Saturday rehearsal (1-3 times per year)
Extra Commitment	Team meetings, training, and fellowship. Probably no more than 1.5 hours per month.
Synopsis	In order for people to participate in corporate worship on a Sunday they need to be able to see the lyrics to the songs we sing. This person, although 'invisible' is as important to the process as the worship leader or band. Without lyrics on-screen in a timely manner, our services become the performance of a few individuals on the stage. Add to that the various graphical presentations we use from time to time, and we are on the way to making our services more visually stimulating. The computer operator also gives lyric cues to the stage vocalists and/or choir when singing feature songs
Skills	Ability to navigate MS Windows and PowerPoint. Good listening skills and ability to focus.
Training	'Easy Worship' (the program currently used for songs), basic knowledge of the projector, PowerPoint, and any other programs we may use for presentation purposes.
Responsibilities	Arrive at 8:00am on Sunday morning, rehearse with the worship team (both praise and worship songs, as well as any feature songs scheduled). Be ready to run through any PowerPoint presentation or videos with the pastor during rehearsal. Be present in the booth for services, staying focused during worship, and anticipating the next move in our sometimes spontaneous worship times
