Time Commitment

8:15am – 12:15. Every 3rd Sunday
Occasional Saturday rehearsal (1-3 times per year)

Extra Commitment

Team meetings, training, and fellowship. Probably no more than 1.5 hours per month.

Synopsis

The video team plays an integral role in the Sunday worship service, but if they do their jobs correctly, they're not noticed at all. The video feed is being broadcasted to the Atrium, Family Room, Nursing Moms Room, and also to the under balcony in the sanctuary. The team performs two vital functions: (1) broadcasting the services live on the TV monitors throughout the church, (2) recording services for use by the pastors and in later video projects. The video director is crucial to these roles. S/he works in conjunction with camera operators and switches between their feeds to ensure an excellent display of the service, coordinates with computer, lighting, and sound board operators, and directs the playback of video clips (although the actual playback will soon be done by someone else). The director is also responsible for troubleshooting equipment failures and coordinating with leadership to stay abreast of service content and changes

Skills

Basic computer ability, interpersonal skills, ability to work under pressure, problem Solving attitude. A creative flair and TV watching experience also come in hand.

Training

Video Toaster (the program used to switch between cameras and to play back clips), basic familiarity with all video, lighting, and audio equipment and wiring

Responsibilities

Arrive at 8:15am on Sunday morning, rehearse with the worship team (both praise and worship songs, as well as any feature songs scheduled). Be present in the booth for services, staying focused during the entire service, and anticipating the next move in our always changing service schedules.
