

COVID-19 UPDATE: 3-24-20

Dear Rockpointe Family,

It was such an encouragement to "see" so many of you again on Sunday for our livestream. You can still find us on Facebook, especially for Family Life Ministry postings like the Sunday Service videos that so many of you have been watching these past two weeks.

As most of you are aware, on Monday the Governor issued a state-wide order to stay home except for necessary activities like shopping for groceries, important medical appointments, etc. There are NO scheduled on-site events at Rockpointe Community Church at this time.

Due to the unfolding situation, as of Monday, March 30, Handprints Christian Early Learning Center will suspend operations until further notice. Handprints team members have already been informed that pay will be provided through the month of April. It is our absolute intention and firm belief that Handprints will reopen in the near future.

That does not mean, however, that ministry is suspended!

The governor's order still gives freedom for churches to engage in vital ministry such as delivering groceries or other essential items to those in need, assisting with emergency home repairs, or other urgent issues that might arise during this time.



The Rockpointe office, while operating with limited personnel on-site continues to remain open to take your phone calls and respond to your inquiries. We have adjusted those hours to 9AM-3PM Monday through Thursday.
